

WAB 50th Anniversary Awards

Introduction

To celebrate its 50th year, WAB is running, for the year 2019 only, three celebratory awards. The awards have varying degrees of difficulty and it is hoped that there is something for the casual WAB'er as well as the ardent ones. Excel spreadsheet "Trackers" have been produced to assist you with the logging of the awards and these will be available for download from the WAB website:

WAB 50th Anniversary Award

This award is based on a points system, with an initial certificate awarded for 10 points and endorsements for each further 10 points. A further certificate and trophy are awarded for multiples of 50 points.

Requirements UK HF

- Squares - 1 point for each 50 worked. Minimum requirement of 10 x the points claimed. E.g. 10 points = 100 squares, 50 points = 500 squares.
- Book Holders - 2 points for each 50 worked. A book holder counts once only irrespective of the number of books held.
- Large Squares - 1 point for each 5 worked.
- Decade - 1 point for each 50 numbers worked, 3 points for all 100.
- Islands - 1 point for each 5 islands worked.
- WAB callsigns – 1 point for each 5. These include the monthly activation of the two club callsigns and any Special Event call issued by OFCOM in celebration of WAB's anniversary.
- Squares ending in 50 - There are 32 squares ending in the number 50. 1 point for each of these.
- WAB DXCC countries - 1 point for each 5 countries in which you worked a WAB member. The 7 "UK" countries count towards this.
- Trig Points - 1 Point for each 5 worked in a "50" square.



Requirements UK VHF, UK Data Modes and Europe HF

- Squares - 1 point for each 25 worked. Minimum requirement of 5 x the points claimed. E.g. 10 points = 50 squares, 50 points = 250 squares.
- Book Holders - 2 points for each 25 worked. A book holder counts once only irrespective of the number of books held.
- Large Squares - 1 point for each 2 worked.
- Decade - 1 point for each 25 numbers worked, 6 points for all 100.
- Islands – 1 points for each 2 worked.
- WAB callsigns – 1 point for each 2. These include the monthly activation of the two club callsigns and any Special Event call issued by OFCOM in celebration of WAB's anniversary.
- Squares ending in 50 - There are 32 squares ending in the number 50. 2 points for each of these.
- WAB DXCC countries - 1 point for each country in which you worked a WAB member. The 7 "UK" countries count towards this.
- Trig Points - 1 Point for each 2 worked in a "50" square.

Requirements Outside Europe

- Squares - 1 point for each 10 worked. Minimum requirement of twice the points claimed. E.g. 10 points = 20 squares, 50 points = 100 squares.
- Book Holders - 1 points for each 5 worked. A book holder counts once only irrespective of the number of books held.
- Large Squares - 1 point for each 2 worked.
- Decade - 1 point for each 25 numbers worked, 6 points for all 100.
- Islands -1 point for each island worked.
- WAB callsigns – 1 point for each 2. These include the monthly activation of the two club callsigns and any Special Event call issued by OFCOM in celebration of WAB's anniversary.
- Squares ending in 50 - There are 32 squares ending in the number 50. 2 points for each of these.
- WAB DXCC countries - 1 point for each country in which you worked a WAB member. The 7 "UK" countries count towards this.
- Trig Points - 1 Point for each worked in a "50" square.

Requirements for Activated

- Squares - 2 point for each 50 activated. Minimum requirement of 5 x the points claimed. E.g. 10 points = 50 squares, 50 points = 250 squares.
- Large Squares - 2 points for each 5 activated.
- Decade - 2 points for each 50 numbers activated, 6 points for all 100.
- Islands -1 point for each island activated.
- Squares ending in 50 - There are 32 squares ending in the number 50. 2 points for each activated.
- Trig Points - 1 Point for each activated in a "50" square.



WAB Golden Squares Award



There are 32 WAB squares ending in the Golden number 50. E.g. C50, SK50, WA50.

A certificate will be awarded for working 5 of these, with endorsements for each further 5. A further free certificate will be issued to anyone working, (or hearing in the case of an SWL), all 32.



WAB 50 Squares Award

This award is issued for working multiples of 50 WAB squares during 2019. A certificate will be issued for the first 50 squares and endorsements for each subsequent 50. A further certificate will be issued for multiples of 500 Squares.
